Fireworks

Please note that City of Burnaby Bylaws only allow fireworks to be discharged on private property on October 31st. No fireworks shall be set off or discharged on public property without a permit from the Fire Chief.

- Celebrate wisely. Teach children that fireworks are not toys & that if they find fireworks, they should TELL an adult. It is unsafe for children to pick up fireworks & bring them to an adult. Only adults should discharge fireworks.
- NO FIREWORKS should be held in hand when lit.
- Do not leave fireworks unattended or close to lighting area.
- Watch children carefully. Young children should not participate in the actual firing & should be kept at least 50—75 feet away.
- Prepare ahead of time. Read all instructions carefully.
- Select a safe area to discharge fireworks. Be aware of overhead hazards, trees, etc.
- Please be kind, keep all pets safely indoors.

School-appropriate Halloween Costumes should...

- not display inappropriate images such as: gratuitous blood, violence or swear words.
- In general, not depict gratuitous violence, promiscuity, or alienate others based on gender, race or religion.
- Allow students to go outside at recess and lunch if the weather permits.
- Not include swords, guns or any other kind of weapon - please leave these items at home.

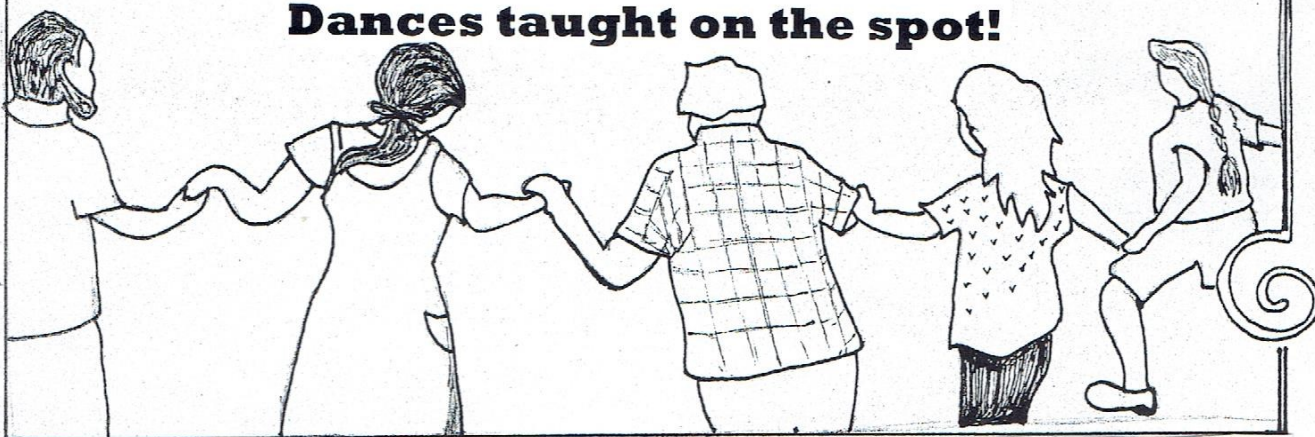
